## **By Court - Judgment:**

Having considered the Petition for Divorce filed on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of June 2023, the Respondent's Affidavit of Consent filed on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023 and having heard the testimony of the Petitioner herein, I am of the considered opinion that the following facts are established on record per Petitioner's evidence;
