I have duly considered the Petition for Divorce filed by the Petitioner herein on the 2nd day of June 2023. I have further considered the Respondent's Affidavit of Consent filed on the 12th day of June, 2023.

Now, after hearing the testimony of the Petitioner herein and considering Exhibit A (the Parties Marriage Certificate), I am of the considered opinion that the following facts are established from all the evidence on record;

- 1) The fact that the Parties have not lived together as husband and wife from 2019 till the date of presentation of the instant Divorce Petition which said period exceeds 2 years consecutively.
- 2) The fact that the Parties to the marriage under consideration have irreconcilable differences.
