By Court - Judgment

This Petition for Divorce was filed by the Petitioner herein on the 19th day of April 2023. Upon being served with the said Petition on the same day (19/04/2023), the Respondent filed an Affidavit of Consent. Refer to court's docket for court bailiff's Affidavit of service as well as the Respondent's Affidavit of Consent; Court bailiff being Fiifi S. Addo.

Now, having heard the evidence adduced by the Petitioner through his testimony, I am satisfied that on all the evidence on record, the following facts are established in support of the Petitioner's claim that his Ordinance Marriage to the Respondent has broken down beyond reconciliation;

- 1) The fact that the parties have not lived together for a continuous period of 3 years immediately preceeding the presentation of the instant Petitioner for Divorce,
- 2) The fact that the Respondent deserted the marriage under consideration and
- 3) The fact that the Parties have irreconcilable differences.

Upon this facts and in light of **Section 2 (1) © (d) and (f) of the Matrimonial Causes Act 1971 (Act 367)**, I find and hold that the Ordinance Marriage celebrated between the Parties herein on 16th day of September 2016 at the Kaneshie District Court in Accra has broken down beyond reconciliation.

I accordingly dissolve the said Marriage this 25th day of April 2023.

The Court's Registrar shall issue a Divorce Certificate to the Parties after cancelling their Marriage Certificate which is to be furnished the Registrar by the Petitioner.

I make no award as to cost.
