TERMS OF SETTLEMENT

BY COURT: The terms of settlement dated the 16th December, 2022 filed by the parties are as follows:

- **a)** The Ordinance marriage celebrated on 29th of September, 2012 at Ledzokuku-Krowor Municipal Assembly, Teshie-Nungua between the parties be dissolved.
- **b)** The custody of three issues to the marriage namely:

- Kwame Asamoah Alock Ten (10) years old
- Kojo Adu Alock Eight (8) years old
- Kwabena Adu Larbi Six (6) years old

be granted to the Petitioner with reasonable access to the Respondent in the following manner:

- The Respondent will have access to the issues of the marriage at every weekend.
- School vacations of the issues of the marriage will be spent with the Respondent.
- Any other period agreed by the parties herein
- c) The Petitioner will continue to maintain the issues of the marriage and shall pay for their educational expenses and medical bills.
- **d)** The Terms of Settlement shall constitute full and final settlement of this matter between the parties.
- **e)** The parties shall bear their legal costs.
- **f)** The Terms of Settlement be adopted as consent judgment by the Court.
- g) The Terms of Settlement herein contained shall be subject to the usual default clause.

BY COURT: The parties agree to the dissolution of the marriage. The customary marriage has been dissolved. The evidence shows that for over two (2) years, they have not lived as husband and wife and efforts by their family to reconcile their differences proved futile. The court finds that the marriage has broken down beyond reconciliation and same is hereby dissolved. The
