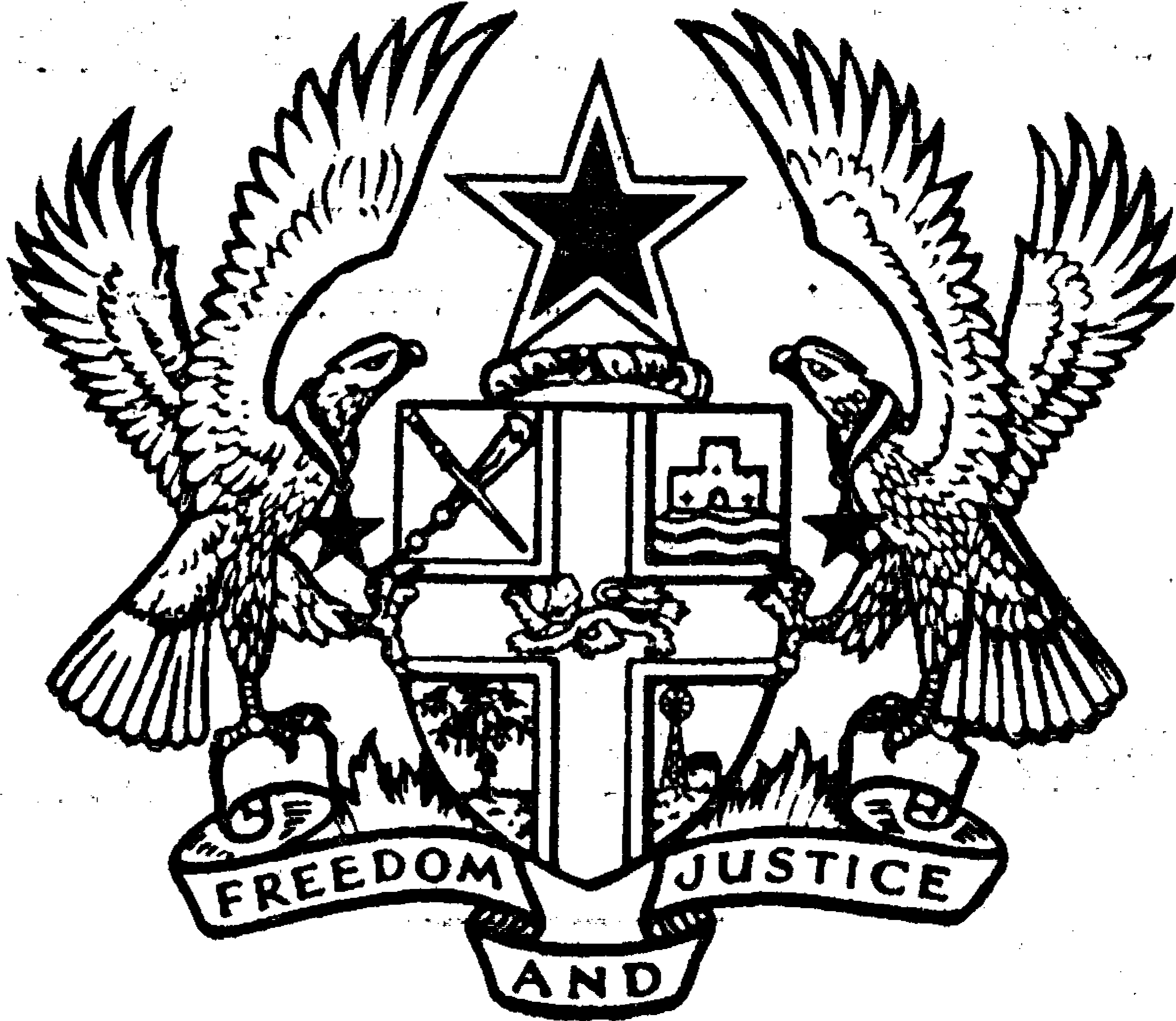

(RECONSTRUCTION) ACT, 1960**

AN ACT to reconstruct the Customs Preventive Service and to provide for other purposes connected therewith.

DATE OF ASSENT: *8th December, 1960*

BE IT ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly in this present Parliament assembled as follows:—

Continuance of service.

1. On the coming into operation of this Act the Customs Preventive Service shall continue to function subject to the provisions of this Act.

2. The Comptroller of Customs may, in rules made under section 261 of the Customs Ordinance (Cap. 167), make provision in relation to the Customs Preventive Service, for the matters specified in subsection (1) of that section.

Commence-  
ment and  
repeal.

3. (1) This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of July, 1960.

(2) Subsection (2) of section 262 of the Customs Ordinance (Cap. 167) (which provides for the control and management of the Customs Preventive Service), the Customs (Preventive Service) Regulations, 1948 (No. 6) and the Customs Preventive Service Ordinance (Cap. 92) (which prohibited members of the Customs Preventive Service from joining a trade union) are hereby repealed.
