THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1970

AN ACT to amend the Criminal Procedure Code, 1960 (Act 30).

DATE OF ASSENT: *2nd July, 1970*

BE IT ENACTED by the Presidential Commission and the National Assembly in this present Parliament assembled as follows:—

1. The Criminal Procedure Code, 1960 (Act 30) is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 46 thereof of the following new section:—

"Ghanaian nationals committing certain offences abroad may be prosecuted in Ghana.

46A. Any citizen of Ghana who—

(a) while employed in the service of the Republic of Ghana or of any statutory corporation does outside Ghana, when acting or purporting to act in the course of his employment any act which if done in Ghana would be punishable as an offence, or

(b) does outside Ghana any act which if done in Ghana would constitute the offence of murder or an offence under section 183A of the Criminal Code, 1960 (Act 29), or

- (c) does outside Ghana any act which if done in Ghana would be punishable as an offence, being an act involving or resulting in the misappropriation, dissipation or loss of any public funds or involving or resulting in any misappropriation, dissipation or loss of or damage to any property of the Republic or of any statutory corporation, or
- (d) does outside Ghana on the premises of any Ghanaian diplomatic mission any act which if done in Ghana would be punishable as an offence,

shall be guilty of an offence of the same nature as the act in question would have constituted if done in Ghana and may, subject to section 46 be proceeded against, tried and punished accordingly.”
