WEST AFRICA EXAMINATION BOARD—ROYAL SOCIETY OF HEALTH EXAMINATION FOR PUBLIC HEALTH INSPECTORS

The annual examination will be held for Public Health Inspectors from 4th to 10th August, 1970, at the following centres:—

Fee for examination or re-examination is £5 5s. (NC12.86), which must be paid in full to the Honorary Secretary, either in postal orders or in cash, should be received by the Honorary Secretary not later than July 4, 1970.

New applicants are advised that-

- (a) They must submit evidence of having been engaged during a total period of at least three years as a Public Health Inspector-in-training, consisting of—
 - (i) a certificate signed by the Principal of a training school approved by the Board stating that they have attended fulltime the approved course of instruction for Public Health Inspectors at that school; and
 - (ii) a certificate signed by a Medical Officer of Health to the effect that they have been in full-time employment of a health authority (excluding such time as may be spent in full-time instruction at school) for a period of not less than six months.

The total time covered by these two certificates to be not less than three academic years; or

- (iii) a certificate signed by a Medical Officer of Health to the effect that they have been in full-time employment of an approved health authority as Public Health Inspectors-in-training for not less than three years, and that they have attended for the prescribed period of not less than 300 working hours, the approved course of lectures and demonstrations provided by the authority.
- (b) Entries must be made on the prescribed form and must be received by the Honorary Secretary in Lagos, not later than July 4, 1970.
- (c) The sum of £1 1s. (N\(\mathcal{C}2.57\)) will be deducted if any candidate withdraws from the examination before 21 days to the examination date; examination fees will not be refunded within 21 days of the examination date.
- (d) Qualified persons wishing to sit the examination should apply for forms from the Senior Health Training Officer. School of Hygiene, P.O. Box 753, Accra. Completed application forms should be returned through the Senior Health Training Officer to the Principal Secretary, Manpower and Training Division, Ministry of Health, P.O. Box M-44, Accra, not later than 23rd May, 1970.
