COURSE OF TRAINING LEADING TO THE GRADE OF LABORATORY TECHNOLOGIST

Applications are invited for scholarship awards for training at the Algonquin College of Technology, Canada, leading to the acquisition of Diploma in Bio-Chemical Technology.

- 2. Qualifications.—Candidates must—
 - (a) be citizens of Ghana;
 - (b) have attained their 18th birthday, but not have reached their 30th birthday;
 - (c) hold the following educational qualifications or their equivalent:—
 - (i) G.C.E. with "O" levels in 2 Science subjects:

English Language Mathematics.

- (ii) G.C.E. "A" levels passes in Chemistry and Physics or Chemistry and Mathematics.
- 3. Selected candidates will be required to enter into bond to complete the course satisfactorily and to serve the Government for a period of five years on completion of the course.
- 4. Candidates who satisfactorily complete the course and obtain the Diploma will be considered for appointment in the Ministry of Health to the pensionable grade of Laboratory Technologist on salary Range 50, 55 (NC1,812-NC3,108) per annum. There will be prospects of progression to higher grades in future.
