Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of Data Printing Supervisor in the Council.

VACANCY FOR DATA PRINTING SUPERVISOR

Applications are invited from suitably qualified candidates for the post of Data Printing Supervisor in the Council.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the supervision of the Data Printing Unit, which is situated at the Council's headquarters in Lagos, Nigeria. The candidate will be required to manage the unit's operations, including the maintenance and repair of the printing equipment, and to ensure that the unit is able to produce high quality data prints in accordance with the Council's requirements.

The successful candidate will be required to have a minimum of five years' experience in the printing industry, preferably in the supervision of a printing unit. The candidate should also have a good knowledge of the English language and be able to communicate effectively with staff and other members of the Council.

Applicants should send their applications, together with copies of their curriculum vitae and three recent photographs, to the Secretary, West African Examinations Council, P.M.B. 100, Lagos, Nigeria. Applications should be received by the Council on or before 15th August 1971.

MEMORANDUM TO THE DIRECTOR GENERAL OF PRINTING

The Director General of Printing is requested to consider the following proposals for the improvement of the printing process at the Council's headquarters in Lagos, Nigeria.

It is proposed that the Council should purchase a new data printing machine, which would be capable of producing high quality data prints in a shorter period of time than the existing machine. The cost of the new machine is estimated to be N25,000.

It is also proposed that the Council should purchase a new data printing unit, which would be capable of producing high quality data prints in a shorter period of time than the existing unit. The cost of the new unit is estimated to be N15,000.

The Director General is requested to consider these proposals and to report to the Council on or before 15th August 1971.
