NOTICE OF RESTRICTION ON TRANSFER OF ASSETS: MINISTERS, MINISTERIAL SECRETARIES, ETC.

WHEREAS the National Redemption Council is satisfied that it is in the interest of the public to impose restrictions on the transfer or other disposal of the assets of the persons mentioned in the Schedule to this notice;

Now THEREFORE in exercise of the powers conferred on the Council by section 1 of the Restriction on Transfer of Assets Act, 1970 (Act 323) this notice is hereby given with effect from the 13th day of January, 1972:

- 1. Except with the permission in writing of the National Redemption Council no person shall-
 - (a) withdraw or transfer any money from any account kept with any banker by any of the persons specified in the Schedule to this Notice;
 - (b) obtain any security or thing deposited with any banker or any document relating thereto, kept with any banker by any of the persons so specified.
- 2. Except with the permission in writing of the said Council, no banker shall-
 - (a) pay or transfer any money out of or from any account referred to in paragraph 1 of this Notice;
 - (b) transfer or deliver to any person any security, thing or document referred to in paragraph 1 of this Notice.
- 3. As required by section 1 of the Restriction on Transfer of Assets Act, 1970 (Act 323), unless renewed, the restrictions imposed by this Notice shall have effect for a period of three months from the publication of this Notice in the Gazette.
