The Dean will be in charge of the general administration and development of the Medical School which is now twelve years old and has produced several generations of doctors. He will be expected to oversee the academic development of the School including curricula revisions, graduate studies, research and extension needs. The physical development of the Medical School into a Medical Centre on a site near the University of Ghana, Legon, will start during the next three years or so and the Dean will be expected to co-ordinate all aspects of such development with the various planning authorities in the University and the country. African experience in medical education or experience in other developing countries with medical problems similar to those of Ghana will be an advantage. The Dean will be expected to promote leadership of a high order in these areas of development and exercise the necessary initiative in a period of growing international co-operation in medical education.
