**PUBLIC HEALTH INSPECTORS EXAMINATION**

The annual Examination for Public Health Inspectors will be held from 4th to 11th August, 1976 at the following centres:—

Forms of application for admission to the examination are available at the Schools of Hygiene in these countries and all applications must be submitted through the *Principals of Schools of Hygiene*. Individual applications will not be considered by the Secretariat.

FEE for examination or re-examination is N21 (£10.10) which must be sent with application form.

NEW APPLICANTS are advised that:

- (a) They must submit evidence of having been engaged during a total period of at least three years as a Public Health Inspector-in-training, consisting of:
  - (i) a certificate signed by the Principal of a training school approved by the Board, stating that they have attached full-time the approved course of instruction of Public Health Inspectors at that school; and
  - (ii) a certificate signed by a Medical Officer of Health to that effect that they have been in full-time employment of a health authority (excluding such time as may be spent in full-time instruction at school for a period not less than six months. The total time covered by these two certificates to be not less than three academic years; or
  - (iii) a certificate signed by a Medical Officer of Health to the effect that they have been in full-time employment of an approved health authority as Public Health Inspectors-in-training for not less than three years and that they have attended course of lectures and demonstrations provided by the authority.
- (b) ENTRIES—must be made on the prescribed form and must be received by the Honorary Secretary, in Lagos, not later than July 6, 1976.
- (c) The sum of N2.10 (£1.1) will be deducted if any candidate withdraws from the examination before 21 days to the examination date: examination fees will not be refunded within 21 days to the examination date.

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO INVITE TENDERS FOR PROCESS CONTROL EQUIPMENT PLANT AND CIVIL ENGINEERING

1. The Company CEMENTS DE L'AFRIQUE DE L'OUEST (CIMAO), an international corporation inscribed in Lome, Togo, and with equity participations of the Governments of Togo, Ivory Coast and Ghana, will build a clinker project with a capacity of 1.2 million tons per year. CIMAO has engaged in contracts with ORIGNY-DESVROISE, France, for provision of technical assistance and with ASSOCIATED PORTLAND CEMENT MANUFACTURERS LTD., England, for provision of engineering and procurement services.

2. CIMAO has requested loans in various currencies from a number of international and bilateral financing institutions, including the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD), and the African Development Bank (B.A.D.). Invitations to tender and for procurement of equipment, the financing of which will involve IBRD, will be carried out according to IBRD regulations. Likewise, the invitations to tender and for procurement of equipment financed by the other financing institutions, without IBRD's involvement, may be required to meet the regulations of these institutions.

3. The project, using dry process, will comprise: two production lines, each with a capacity of 2,000 tons of clinker per day, related support facilities storage, loading facilities both at the plant site (about 80 km north-east of Lome), and a rail/port Terminal in Lome for maritime shipping of a large part of the production. The following lots are envisaged:

- J. Process Control and Instrumentation Equipment, Detailed Engineering, Installation and Commissioning.
- K. Mobile Cranes
- L. Civil Engineering (Plant Site), comprising Site Clearance, Earthworks and Backfilling, Injection Grouting of Foundation Soil, Roads, Drains, Fencing, Rail Sidings, Kiln Piers, Support Piers and Buildings for the Milling and Pre-heating Plants, Chimneys, Raw Meal Blending and Storage Silos of 22,000 tons total capacity, Clinker Storage Silos of 20,000 tons total capacity, Fuel Store, Firing Plant, Workshops, Stores, Garages, Electrical Sub-stations, Dispensary, Canteen and Administrative Buildings.
- M. Civil Engineering (Terminal Site), comprising Site Clearance, Earthworks and Backfilling, Roads, Drains, Fencing, Rail Sidings, Clinker Store of 45,000 tons capacity, Workshop, Electrical Sub-station and Administrative Building.
