- 1. Applications are invited for scholarship award for training leading to the appointment in the Ministry of Health as Medical Laboratory Technician (Technical Officer, Hospital).
  - 2. The qualification and duties are as follows:—
    - (a) Qualification.—Candidates who must be citizens of Ghana must—
      - (i) possess the G.C.E. 'O' Level or its equivalent with five passes in two science subjects (excluding Home Science, Health Science, Agricultural Science) or General Science, Elementary Mathematics, English Language and one other subject.



- (ii) not have attained their 25th birthday. Candidates who sat for the G.C.E. "O" Level Examination or West African Examination in June 1976 and are awaiting results may apply. Their selection will however be on passing the examination.
- (b) Duties.—The Laboratory Technician (Technical Officer) is required to carry out Laboratory tests and other Medical Laboratory assignments, etc.
- 3. Selected candidates will be bonded to complete the course and to serve Government for a period of five years after satisfactory completion of the course.
- 4. The period of training will be three years during which candidates will have formal and on-the-job training at the School of Medical Laboratory Technology at Korle Bu. Candidates who fail to show satisfactory results during the period of training will have their scholarships withdrawn.
- 5. During the period of training candidates will receive a training allowance of C948 per annum for the first year, C984 for the second year and C1,020 for the third year. Candidates who possess the G.C.E. Advanced Level with two science subjects will receive allowance at the flat rate of C1,056 per annum. Failure to pass the final examination at the third attempt will also result in the termination of the award.
- 6. Candidates who satisfactorily complete the course will be considered for appointment to the grade of Medical Laboratory Technicians (Technical Officer) on salary ranges 35 and 42 (\$\mathcal{C}\$1,428-\$\mathcal{C}\$1,620; \$\mathcal{C}\$1,788-\$\mathcal{C}\$2,028). As from next year the School of Medical Laboratory Technology will start training suitably qualified and experienced medical laboratory technicians as medical laboratory technologists at the Korle Bu Teaching Hospital.
