**COMMUNIQUÈ BY THE NATIONAL TRIPARTITE
COMMITTEE (NTC) ON THE 2021 AND 2022
NATIONAL DAILY MINIMUM WAGE**

In line with Section 113 (1)(a) of the Labour Act, 2003 (Act 651), the National Tripartite Committee (NTC) concluded negotiations on the determination of the National Daily Minimum Wage (NDMW) in respect of 2021 and 2022 at its meeting held on Thursday, 3rd June, 2021 in Accra.

The Committee agreed as follows:

1. That the **2021 NDMW is GHS12.53** which is six percent (6%) over the 2020 figure of GHS11.82.
2. That the **2022 NDMW is GHS13.53** which is eight percent (8%) over the 2021 figure of GHS12.53.

The effective date for the implementation of the 2021 NDMW is **4th June, 2021**.

The effective date for the implementation of the 2022 NDMW shall be **1st January, 2022**.


In determining the new rates, the NTC took into account the impact of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic on the national economy, cost of living, sustainability of businesses and desirability of attaining high level of employment.

All establishments, institutions or organisations whose Daily Minimum Wage is below the 2021 National Daily Minimum Wage should adjust their wages accordingly with effect from **4th June, 2021**.

Any establishment, institution or organisation that flouts the new rate shall be sanctioned in accordance with the law.

The NTC recommends that the NDMW should be tax exempt.

The NTC wishes to reiterate its commitment to strengthening social partnership, industrial peace and the improvement of incomes and productivity in both the public and private sectors of the economy.

MARITIME CIRCULAR

Shipping Notice No: 019

PREVENTION OF POLLUTION FROM SHIPS UNDER THE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION FOR THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF MARINE POLLUTION FROM SHIPS

RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF OPEN LOOP SCRUBBERS

The Ghana Maritime Authority wishes to bring this Notice to the attention of all Ship Owners, Ship Operators, Ship Managers, Port Operators and the Shipping Community that the discharge of wash water from ***open-loop exhaust gas scrubbers*** in Ghanalan ports and territorial sea is prohibited.

By this Notice, vessels fitted with open-loop scrubbers calling at Ghana are to use compliant fuels while vessels fitted with hybrid scrubbers are required to switch to the closed-loop mode of operation. This measure is to protect the marine environment and ensure that our ports and territorial waters are clean.

This Notice is in line with Maritime Circular (Shipping Notice No. 012) issued by the Ghana Maritime Authority with regards to Regulation 14.1.3 of MARPOL Annex VI on the sulphur content of fuel oil used on board ships not exceeding 0.50% m/m.

This Notice is issued in accordance with section 479 A of the Ghana Shipping (Amendment) Act, 2011(Act 826), which mandates the Authority to issue Maritime Circulars for the purpose of disseminating relevant information on maritime safety, security, marine pollution prevention and other relevant maritime matters.

By this Notice, all Ship Owners, Ship Operators, Managers, Port Operators, and the Shipping Community are required to comply with the provisions of the Notice accordingly.

Please note that Ghana as a party to MARPOL Annex VI, is taking the necessary steps to provide adequate reception facilities for the collection of residues generated from the operation of scrubbers.
